## Improvements to Interstate 440 Require Lane Shift in Pulaski County

**PULASKI COUNTY (6-9)** – Construction work on I-440 in Pulaski County requires a lane shift and overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will <u>reduce traffic to a single lane</u> and begin moving the precast barrier wall in preparation for <u>shifting eastbound traffic from the outside lanes to the inside lanes</u>. This closure will occur every night from **9:00 p.m.** to **6:00 a.m.** the following morning, starting on **Sunday, June 11** through **Thursday, June 15**.

Additionally on **Tuesday night, June 13**, this process will <u>periodically require a 15 minute closure</u>. Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes as major traffic delays are expected during this time.
